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### Quick Start: Participant/ Guardian Online Sign-Up

- Find your child's school and sign up: Go to healthmovesminds.org and click "Register" then "Join a Team." Type in your school name. When you see your school, click "Sign Up" under your school's name.
- Create your login: If you've never fundraised with us before you will be asked to create an account through our fundraising vendor, Classy. You'll be able to use this login for all SHAPE America fundraising events, so choose a username and password that you'll remember. Just to be sure, write it down and tuck it away in a safe place.
- Fill out the registration form: The site will ask you to enter basic contact information and your child's T-shirt size, then set your fundraising goal.
- Review and complete the waiver: You will be asked to read and accept a waiver on behalf of your child.
- Now the fun begins! Your fundraising page is ready. You and your child can personalize your page, add photos, check your school's progress, and share your cause with family and friends through email and social media.
